

FISHING REPORT
Tuesday, July 27, 2010

The Methow, Chewuch, and Twisp River are open for catch and release fishing. The fishing is excellent. Finally good sized hoppers are appearing and big foam dries with legs are working well. Add a Lightning Bug dropper or a Pheasant Tail Nymph twelve inches below your dry fly for very effective sub-surface bite. Cased Caddis and Stone Nymphs under a indicator also showing good results. The Winthrop to Twisp stretch of the Methow River has been holding some large fish in the 20"+ range.

The reports from most lakes is that it is getting too hot and the bite has been tough. Those getting into fish on lakes are fishing deep (20' down) or fishing the late evening bite.
